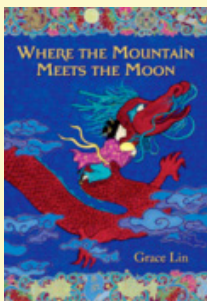
- ◆ Students* arrive at 3:30
